The open summer wrestling was discussed, with the first session to be held June 28 from 5-7. Gina had put it in the Elementary Newsletter and Chad has been receiving calls already. Discussion was held and it was determined that the Elementary School Gym would be the best place. Gina will book it, and Chad will talk to JR Buckley.

The Peterson sign was discussed. It was determined that the Association had already voted on sending the Township \$1,000, and Gina will issue a check for that amount. Other information on the Peterson matter was also discussed.
