

**Cumberland Wrestling Association**  
**Minutes**  
**September 9, 2009**

Meeting was called to order by Vice President Adams at 6:30 p.m.

Attendance: Art Adams, Gina Simon, Wes & Judy Lansin, Isaac Lundquist, Herb & Karen Blaser, Cappy Capra, Kay Capra, Kathy Wiseman and Todd Eggers.

**Approve Minutes of Previous Meeting**

Isaac Lundquist made a motion to approve the June 3 minutes. Art Adams seconded.

**Treasurer's Report**

The treasurer's report was unavailable; however, bills presented for payment and approved were: Cumberland Advocate - \$25.00 and \$75.00; Gator Garb - \$288.14; DeWayne's Nursery - \$97.96; Diversified Design - \$136.00.

**Old & New Business**

The 50-year alumni dinner was discussed. Art indicated he discussed the meal with John Olson at Hilltop and he could do it for \$8.00 per plate. The invites have been ordered and Gina and Judy will get them mailed out as soon as they arrive. John/Ben Peterson have agreed to put on a camp the morning before the dinner. They indicated we could open it up to other school kids and charge \$20-\$25 per kid and the Wrestling Association could keep the profits. Discussion was held on what time; 8-12 or 9-12. Isaac will discuss with Bob and Seth and make contact with the Petersons.

Isaac Lundquist indicated that he had 14 freshman interested in wrestling. He handed out tee-shirts to those in attendance. The sign-up/informational meeting will be held on September 10 for the high school, and they will have a better idea of numbers at that time.

Isaac will discuss budgets with Bob and Seth and report back in October or November.

The wall mats in the wrestling room need to be replaced and discussion was held on that. Isaac reported that some kids have approached him about wanting to get in the wrestling room now. Art will talk with Barry Rose about trying to clear it out so that kids can have that opportunity.

The open summer wrestling was briefly discussed. Isaac indicated that it worked out pretty well, with the exception of when football started. He thought that we could run it until the 2<sup>nd</sup> week in August. Wednesday nights may or may not be better. More discussion will be held on how to make it better next year.

Isaac also discussed the 2-day Black Camp. He indicated about 20 kids attended, and 21 on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day. He thought it would be nice to pursue a 3-day camp with Black next year – 2-days of technique and 1 of conditioning. There was positive feedback from the wrestlers on this camp.

Kay Capra discussed the poster. Isaac will discuss it with the other coaches and the wrestlers and get moving on it.

Art presented Jess Fillion's thank-you note for the scholarship. Art also indicated he thought we made around \$1,700 on the raffle.

The next scheduled Association meeting is October 7, 2009 @ 6:30 p.m. in the High School Library.
