Treasurer's Report

Gina Simon presented the treasurer's report with a current balance of \$9,612.83. The only bill Gina has not paid thus far was for Carl Bents - \$75.00. Chad will send Phil Peterson a thank-you. Discussion was held on how much Mary Patrin and Mary Rogers should be paid for all their work for the 50th. Ken Sparish made a motion to pay each \$500, and Wes Lansin seconded. Judy Lansin will send thank-you's to Dave DaBruzzi and Dan Hopkins as well.

Old & New Business

Chad Olson has had orders for DVD's. Ric Hensel is going to burn some DVD's and Chad will get them mailed out. Chad shared thank-you's from Joe Hegenbarth and John & Sandy Bonneville on the 50th. Don Capra also e-mailed Chad and indicated he thought the 50th was a big hit.

Coach Erickson discussed the current varsity program. Twenty-seven kids are out this year. On Friday there will be wrestle-offs in the Middle School gym. Parents/fans encouraged to attend. They will be taking their team photo by the climbing wall. First match is at Prairie Farm – time has not been determined. Bob decided on January 28 for Parent's Night.

Greg Weaver discussed the K-2 program. Kick-off for PK-8 will be December 15 at 5:30. Parents/wrestlers to get in free (if okay with administration). Judy/Gina will send an ad to the Advocate and put together fliers for the kids. Chad briefly discussed the Altoona tournament. 16-member teams, with weights from 50-160. These kids will begin practice mid-December. It will be held on January 22. Dues for the sign-up will be \$20 per child, \$25 for a family – for K-12. The cookie dough fundraiser will be handed out at sign-up. It will run December 15-January 7. The Association will keep 45%. New shirts for the youth were discussed. Bob E. will ask the high school boys to come up with a logo.

Greg Weaver would like to do some fun activities – potentially going to a waterpark at the end of the season. The Association will see how the fundraisers go and how the budget is sitting.

Bob E. discussed two different tournaments – Osceola or Tomahawk. The kids are limited to 14 events, so a wrestler may have to sit a regular meet to participate.

Discussion was held on the youth tournament. It was determined that moving it up was the best option. January 10, 2010 was selected, if acceptable to Administration. The Middle School tournament will remain on a Friday night.
